Welcome to Smile Big Dentistry – Dr. Lea Bangsil, DMD and thank you for our choosing our office for your dental needs. Our primary objective is to deliver the best and most comprehensive dental care available to our patients. An important part of our mission is making the cost of optimal care as manageable and affordable as possible for our patients.

Payment Options:

- Cash, Check, Visa, Mastercard, American Express or Discover Card. We offer a 5% courtesy accounting adjustment to patients who pay in full for their treatment with cash prior to start of care on treatment plans of \$500 or more.
- Convenient monthly payment Plans¹ from Care Credit allow you to pay over time with no annual fees or pre-payment penalties.

Smile Big Dentistry – Dr. Lea Bangsil, DMD. requires payment prior to the beginning of your treatment. If you choose to discontinue care before treatment is complete, you will receive a refund less the cost of any care received.

For plans requiring more than 3 appointments, alternative payment arrangements may be provided. We are happy to work with your carrier to maximize your benefit and directly bill them for reimbursement for your treatment.² on patients with dental insurance.

There is a fee for any returned check that is not honored by your financial institution (\$35). If your account is placed into collections, there is a \$250 collections fee along with a \$149 filing and process service fee. If a payment arrangement is made or ordered by the court, there is an additional \$200 reinstatement fee. Patient is fully responsible for any fees not covered by their insurance. You are also responsible for any payment mailed directly to you from your insurance carrier for any procedure or service done at our office. Failure to return any check intended for the treatment provided by our office could result in collections and fees.
